DNRM GROUNDWATER WATER TRADING CALCULATOR

Department of Natural Resources and Mines have developed a water trading calculator for groundwater in the Coastal Burnett Groundwater Management Area. This calculator has separate pages for permanent water trades and seasonal water assignments (temporary transfer) and can be found on the business section of the Queensland Government website.



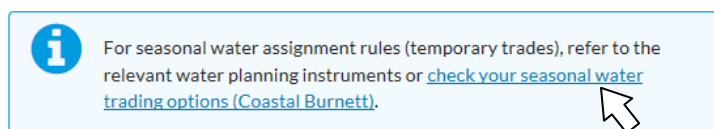
↗ Permanent transfer page

Enter the zones you wish to trade between and the nominal volume and then click Submit. The website will state the amount able to be transferred. It doesn't supply details of who is looking to buy or sell water or how much is for sale.

When combined with the Bundaberg CANEGROWERS water trading register, this enables growers to find additional water to use in dry seasons to maximise the productivity on the farm.

SEASONAL TRANSFER (TEMPORARY TRANSFER)


To access the seasonal trading page click the link on the permanent water trading page as shown below.

Scroll down the page and enter the zone you wish to trade from and the volume. Click submit and a list of Trading Options will display, including maximum volume allowable.
